CAPA presents *Virtuoso Violins, Jazz and a Hoedown* on February 16

Naples, FL — The Cultural and Performing Arts Center (CAPA) presents *Virtuoso Violins, Jazz and a Hoedown* with violinists Glenn Basham and Daniela Shtereva and Jazz pianist Jake Shapiro on Friday, February 16, at 7:30 p.m., at the Wang Opera Center. The evening's program includes a Leclair Violin Sonata in D major and Vivaldi selections, a Jazz set and Aaron Copland's "Hoe-Down." Naples Ballet dancers add the exciting element of interpretive dance with choreography by Christophe Maraval. This is the fourth concert in CAPA's popular six-concert Spectrum Series.

Glenn Basham is concertmaster of the Naples Philharmonic Orchestra. As a jazz musician, Glenn is featured on the Miami Saxophone Quartet's recordings on the Arbors jazz label. **Daniela Shtereva** is a violinist with the Naples Philharmonic. Creative and adventurous, her solo appearances span Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall, the Redlands Symphony and Seattle Chamber Music Festival. **Jake Shapiro** is a teaching assistant at the University of Miami. He is pursuing his Doctor of Musical Arts in Jazz Piano Performance. A native of Chicago, he has been playing and performing piano for nearly two decades.

All CAPA Spectrum Series concerts are at 7:30 p.m. at the Wang Opera Center, 2408 Linwood Avenue, Naples. Individual tickets are \$40 for adults, \$10 for students/children (21 and under with valid ID) and \$50 for VIP seating. VIP includes preferred seating and meet-the-artists after-party.
