CAPA presents *From Paganini to Piazzolla* on March 17

Naples, FL — The Cultural and Performing Arts Center (CAPA) presents *From Paganini to Piazzolla* with violinist Daniela Shtereva and classic guitarist Marco Sartor on Saturday, March 17, at 7:30 p.m., at the Wang Opera Center. The evening's eclectic program presents selections from Niccolò Paganini, Manuel de Falla and Argentine tango composer Astor Piazzolla, including *Centone di Sonate*, *Suite Populaire Espagnole* and *Histoire du Tango*. Naples Ballet dancers add the exciting element of interpretive dance with choreography by Christophe Maraval and Curren Tellalian. This is the fifth concert in CAPA's popular six-concert Spectrum Series.

Daniela Shtereva is a violinist with the Naples Philharmonic. Creative and adventurous, her solo appearances span Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall, the Redlands Symphony and Seattle Chamber Music Festival. **Marco Sartor** is currently the college division guitar instructor at the New World School of the Arts in Miami, Florida. He has performed as a soloist, in chamber music recitals and with orchestras on three continents to critical and public acclaim.
